The Graduate Student Symposium Planning Committee (GSSPC) is a group of 6-8 graduate students who are responsible for planning and executing an all-day symposium at an ACS National Meeting. The GSSPC has full autonomy over the symposium theme, speaker invitations, fundraising, and scheduling. This is a unique opportunity for graduate students to learn how to organize a symposium, as well as make connections at ACS and network with both speakers and industry representatives. **We are now accepting applications** for the GSSPC for the **Fall 2020 National Meeting**, to be held in San Francisco from August 16<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>.

### How to Apply:

1. Form a committee of 6-8 graduate students
2. Compose a 1-page mission statement outlining why your group wants to be the next GSSPC
3. Propose 2 symposium themes along with a list of 8-12 potential speakers for each theme
4. Provide a short biography of each member of your committee
